Treasurer report – BECU Total 72,781.89 Bob did a transfer from saving to Money Market recently. Some checks still coming in from renewal mailing.

VP Report – We're very solvent – we could have a great party (grin ;-)

NLRN representative Steve reported they're working hard – it's an uphill battle. Ed Beltram planning meetings in WA DC Sept 15 to Sept 17th. Costs are going up. Do we have enough \$ allocated in the budget? Do we know who's interested & available to go? Steve Ellis is interested and maybe Katrina & Dwight. Dave Baine, Bob & Jessica all expect to be unavailable. Anyone flying will need real ID?
